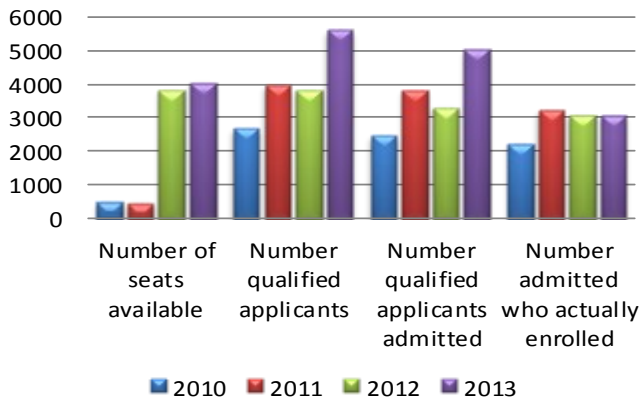

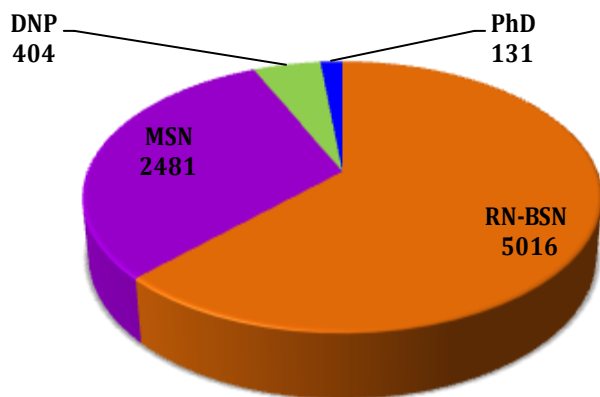

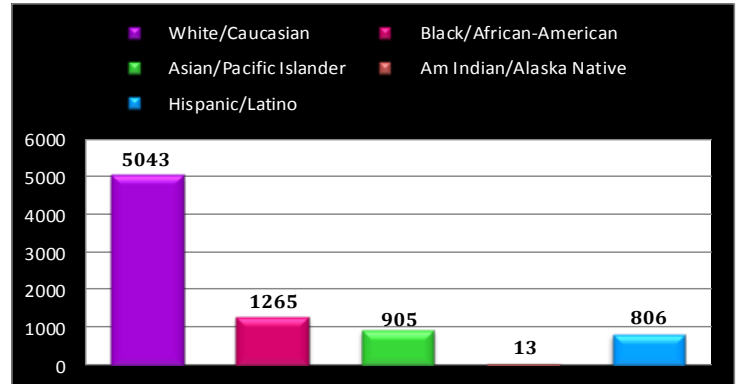


- ✦ There were 2,044 seats available for RN-BSN programs with 4,277 qualified applicants.
- ✦ There were 1,397 seats available for MSN programs, with 1,086 qualified applicants.
- ✦ There were 175 seats available for DNP programs, with 227 qualified applicants.
- ✦ There were 23 seats available for nursing PhD programs, with 38 qualified applicants.

### 2013 STUDENT ENROLLMENT

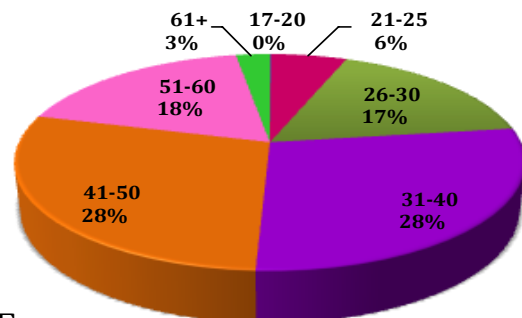


### RACE/ETHNICITY OF POST-LICENSE ENROLLEES



- ✦ RN-to-BSN 14% black, 66% white, and 11% Hispanic
- ✦ MSN 18% black, 53% white, and 10% Hispanic
- ✦ MSN non-clinical 17% black, 65% white, and 8% Hispanic
- ✦ DNP 21% black, 53% white, and 7% Hispanic
- ✦ PhD 24% black, 66% white, 5% Hispanic, 4% Asian/Pacific
