








- There were 2,044 seats available for RN-BSN programs with 4,277 qualified applicants.
- There were 1,397 seats available for MSN programs, with 1,086 qualified applicants.
- There were 175 seats available for DNP programs, with 227 qualified applicants.
- There were 23 seats available for nursing PhD programs, with 38 qualified applicants.




2013 STUDENT ENROLLMENT
