

# NEW JERSEY LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSE (LPN) PROFILE 2013-2014

There were 21,395 licensed LPNs in New Jersey between the years 2013 and 2014 according to the New Jersey Board of Nursing database. Licensed Practical Nurses were asked at license renewal to complete a minimum data set. Of the 21,395 licensed LPNs during this time period, 17,659 respondents completed the survey.



#### EDUCATIONAL LEVEL

**71%** of LPNs completed a vocational and practical nurse certificate program.

# NUMBER OF STATES LPNs PRACTICE

Of the total LPNs respondents, **98%** practicing in New Jersey as their only state.

# **EMPLOYMENT CHARACTERISTICS**

69% of the LPNs are working full-time in nursing; with 85% holding 1 position and 47% identifying their primary employment as nursing homes/extended care assisted living, 17% as other and 15% in home care.

# EMPLOYMENT INTENTIONS AMONG UNEMPLOYED LPNs

**1.43%** of unemployed LPNs were not seeking work as an LPN and **4.32%** were seeking work as an LPN. **1.6%** of LPNs cited home/family as their primary reason for unemployment and **1.45%** identified difficulty finding positions.
